All items marked with an asterisk (*) are items that must be bought from our uniform supplier: Michael Sehgal & Sons, Unit 17 Airport Industrial Estate, Kingston Park, Newcastle, NE3 2EF 0191 2302320. Items of uniform can be purchased online, in-store or via an annual pop-up shop at the school (details provided). Please note we will also endeavour to run a pop-up shop of pre-loved items should we have the necessary donations. The items available in this shop, would be available free of charge to parents.

Items such as hoodies (either with or without zips) and half zip training tops are not permitted as part of the school uniform. When it is cold, students should wear the navy slipover or long-sleeved jumper. Students are also encouraged to wear an outdoor coat on top of their blazer in the colder weather.

Whilst the long-sleeved training top is <u>not</u> compulsory, it can obviously get cold at certain times of the year, therefore this item is recommended as no other long-sleeved top can be worn.

Skirts must not be rolled up in any circumstances.

Footwear

Footwear should be **plain black formal dress shoes** (No gold/silver/metal bows or embellishments whatsoever) and either leather or leather look (Patent leather is fine). Sturdy Doc Martens are **fine as long as there is no coloured stitching**. Designer shoes or trainers (or shoes that resemble trainers) of any sort are not allowed. Plain black ankle length boots are allowed. Please see guidance of examples of acceptable and unacceptable footwear (Appendix 2 below).

<u>Bags</u>

All students are expected to bring a bag to school with the appropriate school equipment of the following items: pencil case, ruler, black pen, green pen, calculator (the maths team can advise on the most appropriate kinds of calculator) rubber, planner and knowledge organiser (provided)

<u>Socks</u>

Please note that trainer socks are prohibited. Students are required to wear black or white ankle socks or opaque tights with a skirt. If trousers are worn, black ankle socks are required.

<u>Jewellery</u>

A small pair of earring studs (one per ear) and a watch are the only types of jewellery that are permitted. (Smart watches/fit bits etc are not permitted). Any other kind of facial piercings are not permitted (Nose, lip, tongue, eyebrow etc)

Make up, false nails, false eyelashes, fake tan and lipstick

Make up should be kept to a minimum and appear natural. False nails and bright nails colours, false eyelashes, lipstick and fake tan are all prohibited.

Hairstyles and colours

The school does not permit students to have 'extreme' haircuts or unnatural coloured hair. Hairstyles and haircuts which are deemed too extreme such as tramlines, stars, extreme pattern styles, Mohican cuts, or brightly dyed hair are also prohibited.

Appendix 1- Examples of Acceptable and Unacceptable Trousers

Acceptable- Plain black, slim fit

Unacceptable- Plain black, skinny fit







Examples of Unacceptable School Footwear

Trainers, Vans, Converse, fashion boots, canvas, sandals, Ugg boots, Doc Martens with coloured stitching, anything designer or with a logo, anything with coloured laces or stitching, anything with gold/silver/metal embellishments no matter how small.
